## 01. Introduction

---

SysCurve MBOX Merge Tool combines multiple MBOX files into one organized MBOX output file.

This guide shows how to add mailbox files, review the merge list, and create a new merged file while keeping source files unchanged.

## 02. Key Features

---

- Merges multiple MBOX files into one output MBOX file.
- Supports mailbox files from common MBOX-based applications and exports.
- Keeps email content, headers, and attachments together during the merge process.
- Lets you choose a safe destination folder for the merged file.
- Works locally on Windows without uploading mailbox data.
- Useful for consolidating scattered mailbox archives before backup, review, or migration.

## 03. System Requirements

---

Requirement	Recommended
Operating System	Windows 7, 8, 10, 11
Processor	Intel or compatible processor
RAM	4 GB minimum; 8 GB recommended for large files
Hard Disk Space	500 MB for installation, plus space for output files
.NET Framework	Version 4.7.2 or higher

---

## 04. Installation Steps

---

1. Download SysCurve MBOX Merge Tool from the official SysCurve website.
2. Run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions.
3. Launch the program from the desktop icon or Start menu after installation.

## 05. How to Use

---

1. Open SysCurve MBOX Merge Tool.
2. Add the MBOX files that you want to combine.
3. Review the selected file list and remove any file that should not be included.
4. Choose the output location for the merged MBOX file.
5. Start the merge process.

6. Open the destination folder and verify the merged output file.
