Introduction

SysCurve PDF Compressor reduces file size by optimizing images and optionally converting to grayscale.

It runs fully offline on Windows and is built for batch compression with clear quality controls.

Key Features

- Compression modes: Low, Balanced, and High.
- Optional grayscale conversion for scans and receipts.
- Per-file settings in a single batch.
- Intelligent image optimization that preserves small graphics.
- Batch processing with progress feedback.
- Skips corrupted or locked files without stopping the run.

System Requirements

- Operating System: Windows 7, 8, 10, 11
- Processor: Intel or equivalent

- RAM: 8 GB or more recommended for optimal performance
- Hard Disk Space: 500 MB for installation, plus space for output files
- .NET Framework: Version 4.7.2 or higher

Installation Steps

1. Download the tool from the official SysCurve website.
2. Run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions.
3. Launch the program from the desktop icon or Start menu.

How to Use

1. Launch SysCurve PDF Compressor.
2. Add PDFs using drag and drop or Add PDF Files.
3. Choose a compression mode and optional grayscale for each file.
4. Select an output folder for compressed files.
5. Click Compress PDF and review the results.
