

SysCurve PDF Merger Tool - Working Guide

Introduction

SysCurve PDF Merger combines multiple PDF files into a single document on Windows without uploading data.

Use it to build a clean packet for reports, contracts, invoices, or long-term archives while keeping originals unchanged.

Key Features

- Merge multiple PDFs into one file while preserving page order.
- Drag and drop input for quick loading.
- Reorder files in the list before merging.
- Handles large jobs with clear progress tracking.
- Skips corrupt or password-protected PDFs and continues the batch.
- Creates a new output file with safe naming to prevent overwrites.

System Requirements

- Operating System: Windows 7, 8, 10, 11
- Processor: Intel or equivalent
- RAM: 8 GB or more recommended for optimal performance

- Hard Disk Space: 500 MB for installation, plus space for output files
- .NET Framework: Version 4.7.2 or higher

Installation Steps

1. Download the tool from the official SysCurve website.
2. Run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions.
3. Launch the program from the desktop icon or Start menu.

How to Use

1. Open SysCurve PDF Merger on your Windows PC.
2. Add PDF files using the Add PDFs button or drag and drop.
3. Arrange the file order using move up and move down controls.
4. Choose the output folder where the merged PDF will be saved.
5. Click Merge PDF and wait for the completion message.
