01. Introduction

SysCurve VCF Merge and Split Tool manages vCard contact files by combining many VCF files or separating one large file into smaller parts.

Use this guide to choose merge or split mode, add contact files, set output options, and create contact files that are easier to import or share.

02. Key Features

- Merges multiple VCF files into a single contact file for easier transfer.
- Splits large VCF files into smaller files when you need separate contact sets.
- Keeps contact fields organized during merge and split operations where source data allows.
- Supports local processing so contact data stays on your Windows computer.
- Useful for phone migrations, Outlook contact imports, and address book cleanup.
- Provides a simple workflow for managing contact files from different sources.

03. System Requirements

Requirement	Recommended
Operating System	Windows 7, 8, 10, 11
Processor	Intel or compatible processor
RAM	4 GB minimum; 8 GB recommended for large files
Hard Disk Space	500 MB for installation, plus space for output files
.NET Framework	Version 4.7.2 or higher

04. Installation Steps

1. Download SysCurve VCF Merge and Split Tool from the official SysCurve website.
2. Run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions.
3. Launch the program from the desktop icon or Start menu after installation.

05. How to Use

1. Open SysCurve VCF Merge and Split Tool.
2. Choose whether you want to merge VCF files or split a VCF file.
3. Add the required vCard files to the software.
4. Review the selected files and choose the output folder.
5. Set split options if you are separating a large VCF file.

6. Start the process and check the saved contact files.
